

CHILDREN'S BIBLE DRILL
INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS AND JUDGES
(PRIOR TO DRILL):

1. Remind participants **NOT** to step back into original position until after the call "Attention" is given.
2. When a participant is asked to read a verse from a Key Passage, it is not necessary to repeat the reference of the verse. It is not a mistake to do so, however.
3. Remind participants of the importance of placing the index finger on the reference **BEFORE** stepping out. It may be on any part of the page in the Book Drill or on any verse in the Key Passage Drill.
4. Remind participants to keep eyes on the Leader at all times when not searching in the Bible.
5. Remind participants not to step back if they realize they don't know or have the right response, but to raise their hand to indicate the error.
6. Remind participants that moving the finger from one reference to another or lifting or turning pages after stepping out are mistakes except whenever necessary to turn a page to read in the Key Passage Drill.
7. Refer to children by number rather than by name during the drill. Participants should line up so that participant #1 is to the left of the audience.
8. Give children one or two sample calls from each type of drill before taking them in for the drill. If you see some obvious errors, call this to the attention of the children.
9. Encourage judges to be true to the rules, but to give a participant the benefit of the doubt if there is any question.
