

Six Steps Guidelines

Below is a list of guidelines that Six Steps team members must agree to follow:

1. Team members are representatives of Jesus Christ and the Crosswalk Ohio Baptist Collegiate Ministry and should conduct themselves in a Christian manner at ALL times especially when dealing with the public. Team members must remember that they are first of all missionaries and secondly performers and should be mindful of this as they assess their own appearance, speech, behavior, and attitude.
2. Students will attend orientation/training and debriefing sessions.
3. Assigned duties (ie. unloading van, preparing costumes, handling props, sound system set-up etc.) must be carried out before leisure time occurs at ministry locations unless it is part of the schedule. Each student will be assigned a specific area to maintain.
4. Students are expected to mail/email written reports to the State Convention of Baptists in Ohio Collegiate Ministry Dept. in order to receive their monthly stipend check. Please be ON TIME with these reports.
5. NO exclusive relationship (dating or otherwise) is allowed while on the field of service.
6. Students are discouraged from receiving guests from home or school while on the field. Please do not invite guests to attend rehearsals or performances without first checking with the co-leaders. There will be times when guests are welcome.
7. Students will remain on the field of service the entire summer without interruption.
8. Students will NOT be allowed to take a personal vehicle on the field of service.
9. Personal cell phone usage during entire term of service will be limited to time while traveling in the team van.
10. In the event that a team member is sick, unable to perform or detained for any reason, please notify the co-leaders as soon as possible.

In addition to these guidelines, each student will be responsible for fulfilling his/her job responsibilities as assigned by the local missions supervisor. Upon acceptance as a Six Steps team member you will receive a member handbook, which more clearly defines the details of these guidelines. Students are encouraged to enter into missions with a giving heart, ready to be flexible and do whatever is necessary to spread God's message to the local community.
