

# FAMILY WEEK 3-7 JUNE 2019 - REGISTRATION DETAILS

## ACCOMMODATIONS AND PRICING:

- Prices per person, per week, ***includes all meals*** & socials after evening chapel (watermelon, sundaes, s'mores) with ***full use of ALL camp amenities/activities!***
- Children under 6 are ½ price; infants under 2 (no meals) - no charge, other than \$10 registration fee.
- ***Dorms (Evergreen and Cabins): \$145 per person, per bunk, for entire week!***
- Accommodations with furnishings and linens/towels provided, vary by occupancy:

- Non-lodging day visitors: \$10 registration fee plus meals: breakfast (\$4), lunch (\$6), and/or dinner (\$8).

## CHECK-IN (JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup>, 2:00, DINING HALL) – WHAT TO BRING:

- **Registration balance due: Cash, Check, or Money Order (only, please).**
- Staying in Dorms or Cabins - you will need to bring sheets, blanket, or sleeping bag, pillows, towels, wash cloths, soap, and personal toiletry articles.
- Staying in Lakeside, Buckeye, and Beech - the rooms are furnished with towels, sheets, blankets, and pillows. You will need to bring your own personal toiletry articles.

## Rules and Regulations:

### Registration (deadline May 18th)

- **NO ONE** allowed on grounds that is not pre-registered (including non-lodging day guests).
- Deposit must be received by deadline to complete reservations made with on-line form.

### Check-in (June 3rd)

- Will take place in the dining hall unless there are over 125 in attendance, then registration must be held in the gym. Check-in ***will not begin before 2:00pm***. You must be checked out of your rooms by 12:00 noon and breakfast will be the last meal served.

### Meals

- There will be no seconds on servings; extra food will be placed on the salad bar.
- The food service line closes at 9:00am, 1:00pm and 7:00pm.
- Groups should move from the dining area after each meal to allow staff to clean the eating area.
- We are unable to provide extra ice to fill ice chests, you may purchase ice at the snack bar during summer operation

### General Rules and Guidelines

- All retreats, camps, and assemblies must have a well-planned spiritual and recreational program (subject to approval).
- All campers, during camps, retreats, and assemblies, are required to attend all services unless providentially hindered.
- Everyone is expected to dress according to the highest Christian standards at all times.
- Campers shall bring no pets on the grounds.
- No cooking shall be allowed in rooms or cabins.
- No swimming is permitted in the pool without a lifeguard on duty.
- No swimming in Darty Stowe Lake.
- No firearms or fire-works are permitted on the grounds.
- Reasonable lights-out time must be established by each director for all overnight meetings at the assembly.
- **Anyone destroying, mutilating, or defacing property of the assembly will be responsible for the cost of repairing or replacing same.**
- The use of paddleboats is off limits unless a dock attendant is present.
- Gym closes at 12 midnight.
- Alcohol, and illegal drug usage is prohibited. **All facilities are smoke free.**

### Insurance

- Each registered person attending the assembly is covered for accidental injuries on an excess basis. **Your personal insurance will be the primary coverage.** All injuries must be reported to the camp director/staff or their designee.
